Quick Hits

- Navy will make its first of two trips in a 10-day span to New York's state capital city of Albany to face traditional power Siena on Wednesday night at the Times Union Center. Navy will also face the University of Albany on Nov. 25.
- Tip-off is slated for 7:00 pm and the contest will be televised by Time-Warner Sports (in New York) and online via Siena's All-Access platform. **Pete Medhurst** will handle the call courtside for Navy radio on WNAV (1430 AM, 99.9 FM, wnav.com) and SIRIUS Satellite Radio (Channel 134), beginning with the pregame show at 6:45 pm.
- This will be the first meeting in school history between the two teams. Siena is the second of six first-time opponents on this year's slate.
- Navy is off to a 2-0 start for the first time in nine seasons, dating back to the 2002-03 campaign. Navy last started 3-0 in the 1998-99 season. The Mids are 2-0 for only the fourth time since joining the Patriot League in 1991-92 (1993-94, 1998-99, 2002-03, 2011-12).
- First-year head coach **Ed DeChellis** became the first coach to win his Navy debut since **Dave Smalley** defeated Baltimore, 65-59, to start the 1966-67 season. DeChellis and the Navy squad won at Longwood last Friday night, 78-70. The previous five head coaches had all dropped their Navy opener.
- **DeChellis** then became the first coach to start his Navy career 2-0 since Naismith Basketball Hall of Famer **Ben Camevale** started 2-0 in the 1946-47 season. The last Navy coach to start his career 3-0 was **John Wilson**, who began his career 9-0 in the 1926-27 season.
- Navy is outscoring its opponents by an average of 21.0 points per game at 83.0 to 62.0 points per game.
- Navy is 8-5 in its last 13 games dating back to last year. In the previous 24 games spanning two seasons (2009-10, 2010-11), Navy was 5-19.
- Navy has outrebounded consecutive opponents by at least eight rebounds in each game for the first time since December 2-5, 2008, against Texas-San Antonio and Penn.
- Navy has shot at least 54.0 percent from the field in consecutive games for the first time since November 14-19, 2006, against Brown (.543) and Stony Brook (.581). Navy shot 54.0 percent against Longwood and 56.5 percent against Penn State Altoona.
- Navy has recorded at least 20 assists in two straight games for the first time since Feb. 7-10, 1999, against Army and Holy Cross. Navy had 20 assists against Longwood and 21 against Penn State Altoona.
- Navy's 33 three-point attempts equal the fewest in a two-game span since Dec. 2-5, 2008, against Texas-San Antonio (11) and Penn (17). Navy had 15 three-point attempts vs. Longwood and 18 against Penn State-Altoona. Navy has made at least five three-pointers in 13 consecutive games and at least one three-pointer in 247 straight games, dating back to the 2002-03 season.
- Navy has had 41 assists on 62 made baskets this season and is shooting 50-of-79 (.633) from inside the three-point line so far this year.
- Navy has had eight different players score in double figures through two games this season. Last year, Navy had nine players reach double-figure scoring in a game during the entire season.

Previewing Siena

• Siena has been one of the top mid-major programs of the last few years and expectations are high that the Saints will once again be strong after last year's 13-18 record. The Saints return two starters, but will be without the services of returning starting point guard **Rakeem Brookins**, who will miss the entire season with a bulging and herniated disk in his back.

• The contest will be the season opener for the Saints, who are picked to finish sixth in the competitive Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC). The Saints have been dealt some big blows in the last couple of weeks as a pair of highly-regarded freshmen from Africa were declared ineligible in late October by the NCAA, on top of Brookins' injury. The Saints must also replace one of the school's all-time greats in **Ryan Rossiter**, who was the MAAC Player of the Year, after averaging 18.7 points per game and 13.2 rebounds per game.

• Siena will still pose quite a formidable task, especially on the interior, where it is expected to start three players 6-6 or taller. **OD Anosike** is the most-decorated of the trio, averaging 8.9 points per game and 6.8 rebounds per outing a year ago. **Owen Wignot** also returns after averaging 6.6 points and 3.6 rebounds in 28 starts. Guard **Kyle Downey** appeared in 23 games, averaging 6.2 points per game last winter.

Series History With Siena

• This will be the first meeting between the two teams.

• Navy is 43-16 (.729) all-time against teams from the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (1-1 vs. Canisius, 4-0 vs. Fairfield, 20-4 vs. Loyola (Md.) and 18-11 vs. Manhattan). Two of Navy's four wins against Fairfield came in the 1985-86 seasons when Siena's current head coach **Mitch Buonaguro** roamed the Fairfield sidelines as its head coach.

• Navy is 152-121 (.557) all-time vs. Division I schools in the state of New York.

• Lastly, Navy is 3-1 all-time on November 16.

Up Next

• After Navy heads to the New York Capital region to face traditional power Siena on Wednesday, the Mids will catch a flight on Thursday morning, then return to the airways again for a Saturday, Nov. 19, contest at Quinnipiac in Hamden, Conn.

• Navy leads the series with Quinnipiac, 1-0, defeating the Bobcats on Nov. 30, 2009, when **Chris Harris** banked in a 45-footer as the clock expired to give Navy a 65-62 victory at Alumni Hall.

• The Mids will then return home to face Conference USA member Tulane on Tuesday, Nov. 22, at Alumni Hall. It will be the first meeting against the Green Wave.

• Navy closes out the hectic travel schedule with another flight to Albany, N.Y., to take on the University of Albany in the team's first meeting on Friday, Nov. 25.

• Navy ends the Thanksgiving Holiday with a home game on Sunday, November 27, against Mount St. Mary's. Navy leads the series with the Mount, 8-6, including an 81-68 decision in Emmitsburg last year.

A Navy Win Over Siena Would ...

• Give Navy a 3-0 start for the first time since the 1998-99 season.

• Improve Navy's road record to 2-0 after going 4-11 in true road games during the 2010-11 season.

• Allow **Ed DeChellis** to start his Navy career 3-0, becoming the first coach since **John Wilson** in 1926-27 to do so.

• Improve its record to 9-5 over the last 14 games dating back to last year.

More Quick Hits

• Navy will be facing a team playing in its season opener for the second straight game as Siena tips off its season on Wednesday night. Penn State Altoona was playing its season opener on Sunday afternoon.

• Of teams across the country that have played at least two games this year (through Sunday), Navy is tied for third in the country in field goal percentage (.554) behind Texas A&M and Indiana.

• Navy's starting lineups during the first two games have featured one senior (**Jordan Sugars**) and four sophomores and / or freshman. In the opener against Longwood, Navy started one senior (**Sugars**), three sophomores (**Avila**, **Loupos** and **Roberts**) and one freshman (**Alter**). In the win over Penn State Altoona on Sunday, **Wyatt** (a sophomore) started for Alter.

• Through Monday's games, Navy has two of the Patriot League's three wins so far during the 2011-12 season.

• Navy ranks as the 10th-youngest, least-experienced team in America for the upcoming season in terms of years of experience per player. Of Navy's 16 players on the roster, 12 are freshmen or sophomores and the lone junior, **Jordan Brickman**, did not play basketball during his first two years at Navy.

• Senior guard **Jordan Sugars** ranks 20th on the Navy career scoring list with 1,043 points. He is also tied for 20th on the school's career rebounding list (499) and fifth on Navy's career three-pointers made list (159).

• **Sugars** needs 457 points and 101 rebounds to join past Navy greats **David Robinson** (1984-87; 2,669 pts, 1,315 rebs), **Vernon Butler** (1983-86; 1,952 pts, 1,115 rebs) and **Kevin Sinnott** (1976-79; 1,687 pts, 797 rebs) as the only players in school history with 1,500 points and 600 career rebounds. Standing just 6-3, **Sugars** is already the shortest player in school history to become a part of the 1,000-point / 500-rebound club.

Quick Hits Continued

- **Sugars** was one of three players returning nationally (UC Santa Barbara's **Oriando Johnson** and Missouri State's **Kyle Weems**) to average 16.0 points per game and 6.0 rebounds per game and make at least 60 three-pointers a year ago.
- **Sugars** saw his streak of eight straight games scoring in double figures end against Penn State Altoona, but he has still made a three-pointer in nine straight games.
- **Sugars** has scored in double-figures in 51 of his 89 career games and has 19 career 20-point games. Since the start of his sophomore season, **Sugars** has reached double-figures in 49-of-60 games and has made a three-pointer in 55-of-60 games during that span.
- **Carlton Smith** is shooting 13-of-19 (.684) from the field during his career. He is already 5-of-6 (.833) this year.
- **Kevin Alter** became the third freshman in school history to start at point guard in the season opener, joining **Corey Johnson** (2004-05 season) and **Bruce Grooms** (1976-77) as the only players to do so.
- **J.J. Avila** needs 18 points for 400 in his career. If he were to get it against Siena, he would do so in his 34th career game, which would be tied for the third-fastest mark since freshmen became eligible before the 1972-73 season. **John Clune** (1952-54) owns the record at 19 games, but he did it in his first season as a sophomore when freshmen were not eligible to play.
- Although the season is young, **Avila** ranks fifth in the Patriot League in rebounding (7.0), first in field goal percentage (.786) and second in assists (4.5). Of players that have played at least two games, **Avila** is fifth in the country in field goal percentage (.786).
- **Jordan Brickman** is the lone junior on the team and has six assists against two turnovers in 23 minutes of action. **Brickman** was recruited by **Billy Lange** as a freshman, but left the team during his freshman season. He has since rejoined the squad and gives the Mids a viable option at the point guard position.
- **Thurgood Wynn** has scored 16 points in just 20 minutes so far this year. After shooting 13-of-37 (.351) as a freshman, **Wynn** is shooting 7-of-10 (.700) from the field so far this year.
- **Jared Smoot's** first two baskets during his career at Navy have been thunderous dunks, both coming against Penn State Altoona. **Chall Montgomery** also scored his first career points on a breakaway dunk against the Lions.

Drop And Give Me 20,000

- **Thurgood Wynn** has become the answer to the trivia question of "Who scored Navy's 20,000th point in Alumni Hall history?", when he did so at the 12:43 mark of the first half with a lay-up in the win over Penn State Altoona on Sunday.
- With the win over Penn State Altoona, Navy is now 174-102 (.630) in its 21st year in the facility and since the start of the 2008-09 season, Navy is 29-14 (.674) at Alumni Hall.
- In its 276 games at the facility, Navy has scored 20,074 points for an average of 72.7 points per game to 18,551 points and 67.2 points per game for its opponents.

Point Guard Production

- One of the big question marks coming into the year would be who would step up and take control of the point guard position. So far, three players have shown they are more than capable of running the show.
- The trio of freshman **Kevin Alter**, sophomore **Brennan Wyatt** and junior **Jordan Brickman** have all played well at the start of the year and one of them has been on the floor for all 80 minutes this year.
- So far, the trio is averaging 10.5 points per game, 5.0 rebounds per game and 5.5 assists per game while averaging just 3.0 turnovers per game.
- However, the trio will easily face its stiffest competition of the year on Wednesday night.

DeChellis Takes Over Navy Hoops Program

- On May 23, Navy Director of Athletics **Chet Gladchuk** announced that **Ed DeChellis** was hired as the program's 19th coach in school history. **DeChellis** took over for **Billy Lange**, who left Navy to take the associate head coach position at Villanova. **Lange** served as the head coach for seven seasons, compiling a 92-115 record.
- **DeChellis** arrives at Navy from Penn State, where he led the Nittany Lions to a runner-up finish in the Big 10 Tournament, a second-round NCAA Tournament appearance and a 19-15 overall record. In 2009, **DeChellis** guided his alma mater to an NIT Championship and a school-record 27 victories while being named the league's Coach of the Year. He arrives in Annapolis with a 219-231 in 15 previous seasons as a collegiate head coach.

DeChellis Enjoys Success in Season Openers

• First-year Navy head coach **Ed DeChellis** improved to 12-4 (.750) in his 16 season openers with the win over Longwood. He has now won seven straight season openers after winning his last six openers at Penn State. **DeChellis** went 5-2 in seven openers at East Tennessee State and 6-2 at Penn State.

• The win also allowed **DeChellis** to be the first Navy coach to win a season opener since **Dave Smailey** won his first game to tip the 1966-67 season. The five previous coaches had all lost their debut game at Navy.

Navy Sophomores Lead Way

• After a sensational year by the six-member class of 2014 as freshmen, the group got off to another stellar start in the 2011-12 season. The six-member group scored 49 of Navy's 78 points in the win over Longwood. Four members, **J.J. Avila** (11), **James Loupos** (11), **Isaiah Roberts** (11) and **Brennan Wyatt** (10), all scored in double figures, while **Thurgood Wynn** added a career-high six points in just 11 minutes.

• Then in the win over Penn State Altoona, the group scored 32 more points led by **Wynn's** 10 and **Avila's** 14.

• So far this year, the group is averaging 40.5 points per game, 14.5 rebounds per game and 9.0 assists per game while shooting 30-of-47 (.638) from the field and 5-of-10 (.500) from three-point range.

• Last year, the group scored 762 points, the most for a freshmen class in school history. The group averaged 24.6 points per game, just shy of the 25.7 the freshman class of 2006 averaged for the school record.

All That You Are Is a Shooting Star

• **J.J. Avila's** 6-of-6 performance against Penn State Altoona landed him in the Navy single-game recordbooks. His performance ranks him tied for sixth on the school's single-game field goals made without a miss list.

• **Avila** was 5-of-8 against Longwood and is a sizzling 11-of-14 (.786) from the field, including 3-of-4 (.750) from behind the three-point arc.

• Navy's 28-point halftime lead against Penn State Altoona was tied for the ninth-largest in a game in school history. It was the largest halftime lead since owning a 30-point lead (49-19) against Washington (Md.) on Dec. 20, 2006.

Navy Trio to Carry Load

• Senior **Jordan Sugars** and sophomores **J.J. Avila** and **Isaiah Roberts** appear to figure prominently this year in Navy's offense.

• Navy returns just 57.6 percent of its points from last year, returning 1,217 of its 2,113 points. Of the 1,217 points coming back, the trio accounted for 980 of them (80.5 percent).

• The group did not disappoint in Navy's win over Longwood, scoring 43 of Navy's 78 points (55.1 percent). In the win over Penn State Altoona, the group managed just 23 of Navy's 88 points (26.1 percent).

Balanced Attack Paces Mids

• Averaging 83.0 points per game, one would expect some Navy scorers to be putting up huge numbers. That is not the case early on.

• Head coach **Ed DeChellis** has just two players averaging in double figures (Jordan Sugars at 14.0 ppg and J.J. Avila at 12.5 ppg), but has nine other players that are averaging at least 4.0 points per contest.

• In the win over Penn State Altoona, no player saw more than 18 minutes of action and eight players scored between five and 14 points. In addition, five players recorded at least three assists and six players grabbed at least three rebounds.

• Of the 10 players that have attempted at least five field goals this year, just **Jordan Sugars** (.474), **Donya Jackson** (.444) and **Worth Smith** (.333) are shooting under 50.0 percent from the field.

• Navy has already had eight different players record double-figure scoring games. Just nine players reached double-figure scoring last year.

Sugars About to Join Elite Group

• With his next rebound, **Jordan Sugars** will join a rather exclusive group of Navy players to have scored 1,000 points and grabbed 500 career rebounds.

• Standing just 6-3, **Sugars** could become the shortest player in Navy school history to grab 500 rebounds.

• With 457 points and 101 rebounds, **Sugars** would become the fourth player, and first during Navy's Patriot League era, with 1,500 points and 600 rebounds.

Navy Enters Year With Little Experience

- When Navy takes the court in 2011-12, it will do so as one of the nation's youngest teams. Navy will have three seniors, one junior, six sophomores and six freshmen on the traveling roster. The total amount of games played by the nine returnees is just 306, with 87 of them coming from senior captain **Jordan Sugars**.
- The combined number of starts by the nine returnees is just 102, with 53 coming from Sugars.
- Navy ranks as the 10th-youngest, least-experienced team in America for the upcoming season. Of Navy's 16 players on the roster, 12 are freshmen or sophomores and the lone junior, **Jordan Brickman**, did not play basketball his first two years at Navy.
- Navy's newcomers accounted for six points, 11 rebounds and four assists in 39 minutes of action in Navy's win over Longwood.
- In the win over Penn State Altoona, the newcomers accounted for 35 points, 15 rebounds and nine assists against just three turnovers in 77 minutes of action.

Always Near the Top

- Navy is 30-26 in the Patriot League since the start of the 2007-08 season, posting the third-best Patriot League record during that four-year span. The 30 wins are the third most in the Patriot League during that span, behind American (41-15) and Bucknell (32-24). From the 2001-02 season through the 2007-08 season (seven years), Navy won a combined 32 PL games.
- With Navy tying for fourth and American placing second in 2010-11, the two teams are the only programs in the league with top-four league finishes in each of the last four years.

Outperforming Expectations

- Over the last eight years (including this year), Navy has been selected sixth or lower in every preseason poll to date. And in six of the seven years, Navy has outperformed its preseason placing. The lone exception came in the 2005-06 season, when Navy was picked sixth and finished seventh.

What's Coming Back

- Navy returns roughly 60.0 percent of its production from last year after graduating four seniors that played in a combined 379 career games.
- The Midshipmen return 1,217 of their 2,113 points scored from last year (57.6 pct.).
- Navy returns 62.9 percent of its 980 rebounds from last year (616 rebounds returning).
- The Midshipmen return just 55.5 percent of their 387 assists from a year ago (215 assists returning).
- The area that Navy returns the most is three-pointers made (67.8 pct.) and three-point attempts (66.9 pct.).
- The category that Navy returns the least is free throws made (49.3 pct.) and free throw attempts (50.6 pct.).

From The "Did You Know" Category

- The NCAA-approved, standard three-point line is 25 years old this year and Navy played in the first game featuring the line. The No. 9-rated Midshipmen faced 17th-rated North Carolina State in the 1986 Hall of Fame Tip-Off Classic in Springfield, Mass., on Nov. 22, which tipped off the 1986-87 college basketball season.
- Trailing by two at 84-82, the Wolfpack's **Kenny Drummond** ironically buried a three-pointer with 14 seconds left to lift N.C. State to an 86-84 victory. The Midshipmen were led by **David Robinson** with 36 points.
- Navy was 3-of-4 from long distance in the contest, while North Carolina State went 10-of-20.

Preseason Accolades

- Navy senior guard **Jordan Sugars**, sophomore forward **J.J. Avila** and freshman guard **Donya Jackson** were all mentioned as Patriot League award winners by several preseason publications.
- **Sugars**, the league's second-leading returning scorer (16.0 ppg) and fourth-leading returning rebounder (6.0 rpg) was selected first-team preseason All-Patriot League by *The Sporting News*, *Lindy's*, *Athlon*, *Rivals.com* and the Patriot League.
- Meanwhile, sophomore **J.J. Avila**, the 2011 Patriot League Rookie of the Year, was selected to the second team by *Lindy's Magazine*. *Lindy's* said, "**Avila**, Navy's first Patriot League Rookie of the Year, can't sneak up on anyone anymore, but has the talent to be better this year."
- Lastly, freshman guard **Donya Jackson** was named as the Patriot League's Top Newcomer by *The Sporting News*. Jackson was a two-time Baltimore Catholic League Defensive Player of the Year and averaged 22.1 ppg, 6.8 rpg and 6.0 apg a year ago at Mercersburg Academy.

Ed DeChellis

Head Coach | Penn State (1982)

1st Year at Navy: 2-0 (1.000) | 16th Year Overall: 221-231 (.489)

- Ed DeChellis is in his first year as the head coach of the Navy basketball program after a pair of successful stints at East Tennessee State and Penn State. DeChellis is the 19th head basketball coach in the 105-year history of Navy basketball.
- DeChellis, who is 52, led Penn State to a 19-15 record and a fourth place finish (9-9) in the Big Ten in 2010-11, including the Nittany Lions first appearance in the Big Ten Championship Game and the school's first trip to the NCAA Tournament since 2001.
- DeChellis was the 2009 Big Ten Coach of the Year, just the second Penn State basketball coach to ever earn coach-of-the-year honors, as he guided a Nittany Lion team that started three sophomores to a school-record 27 wins and the program's first-ever national tournament title in winning the 2009 NIT. Along the way Penn State tied a program record for regular season wins (21), posted its second-most Big Ten Conference wins (10) and second-best finish (4th) ever, recorded just the 10th 20-win season in program history and set a record for home wins (17).
- His coaching performance in 2007-08 had many of his Big Ten colleagues and members of the media pointing to him as the conference's coach-of-the-year. Primed for a run to the post-season in his fifth year at the helm, DeChellis saw his leading scorer, rebounder and preseason All-Big Ten first-team pick Geary Claxton go down with a torn ACL 16 games into the season. Second leading scorer and rebounder Jamelle Cornley also suffered a knee injury that limited him for much of the season and caused him to miss six games, including the last three. All DeChellis did was lead a team that started four freshmen and five newcomers to its most Big Ten wins and best Big Ten finish since 2001. Along the way his young Lions knocked off No. 7 Michigan State and No. 17 Indiana while winning five straight home games to end the campaign.
- The Nittany Lions reached the NIT in 2006, DeChellis' third year at the helm. Despite playing the youngest (12 underclassmen and one senior) and smallest line-up (just one player over 6-6 playing more than four minutes per game in league play) in the Big Ten, DeChellis led Penn State to its most overall wins (15), most non-conference wins (eight), most Big Ten wins (six), first Big Ten Tournament win and first post-season appearance (NIT) in five seasons.
- DeChellis' recruiting and coaching helped Penn State claim its first ever Big Ten Freshman-of-the-Year (Jamelle Cornley, 2006) and three straight members of the Big Ten All-Freshman Team (Marlon Smith, 2004; Geary Claxton, 2005; Jamelle Cornley, 2006). The Lions had none before his arrival. He also set about changing and revitalizing the program's culture - stressing family, a team-first attitude and a commitment to excellence without shortcuts that his players embraced and took ownership of.
- DeChellis wrapped up the year by being named the 2006 National Coaches Vs. Cancer Man-of-the-Year for his contributions in raising funds and awareness in the fight against cancer. DeChellis was presented the award by ESPN's Jay Bilas before a large gathering of his peers at the Laurel Valley Golf Club in western Pennsylvania.
- Penn State was coming off two consecutive seven-win seasons when DeChellis was named the 11th head coach in program history in April of 2003. Energizing the fans and players immediately, he helped guide Penn State to nine wins in his first season, better than each of the prior two seasons, with fewer players on scholarship than the previous year.
- In 1986, DeChellis returned to Penn State and began a very successful 10-year run as an assistant coach for nine years under Bruce Parkhill, a mentor to whom he credits his development as a coach, and one season under Jerry Dunn. DeChellis helped guide Penn State to four straight post-season appearances from 1989 through 1992.
- DeChellis returned to Penn State as the head coach after a very successful seven-year run as the head coach at East Tennessee State University. At ETSU he turned a last place Buccaneer team into a three-time conference division winner, a conference tournament champion and took ETSU to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in a decade.
- Showcasing the ability to build a program from the foundation up, DeChellis had his most successful seasons in his last three years. During that span, his ETSU teams went 56-31 and won three straight Southern Conference North Division titles.
- DeChellis has seen every senior that has played for him over his 15 years as a head coach graduate, is a 1982 graduate of Penn State.
